February Meeting Minutes

- Treasurer, Bill Ritchie, read the financial report. The financial report was accepted by Rich Horvath and seconded by Bill Dummitt.
- Field Maintenance Report: Field currently has standing water from winter weather. Spring maintenance will be needed weather permitting.
- Safety Report: No accidents have been reported.

Old Business

- Field's landlord has come to an agreement with President, Neil Mabrouk, that the lease will be extended for one more year at the current rate of \$2650 / yr.
- Search for indoor flying continues current searches have ended in property owners' worried about damage.

New Business

- FAA has mandated that all unmanned aircrafts weighing more than 0.5lbs must have a registration number attached to the aircraft. Each aircraft does not need a separate registration number only one registration number per pilot.
- AMA members are now required to register with the FAA to avoid federal enforcement and potential penalties.
- LCRC Secretary Kane Hogan, is ready to help with the new regulations. Kane will assist any members needing help getting registered.
