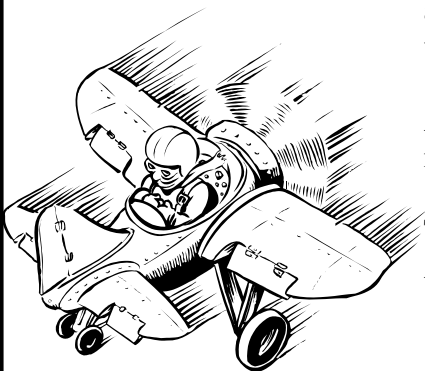

John Halfhill made adjustments to the new mower, so it cuts better and lower now. The mower is at the lowest possible setting.

The shelter, a 20x25 steel construction was to be here the weekend of July 4th. As of the end of this week, it has yet to arrive. It is up now, as of July 29, 2004. It cost Appx. \$3,000.

New Business: Model Mania is August 15th. Every one who wishes to fly in this event must be registered no later than August 10, 2004. You can register on line or by paper form picked up from the meeting. Please remember to include what event you wish to fly in, and your home phone or cell phone number. On August 15, 2004, constestants must be at the field NO LATER than 12pm. If you show up after that you will not be allowed to fly. There will be a pilots meeting at 12:45pm, and the flying will start at 1:00pm. There will be World War era, Combat, and Scale events, so far. Set up is on Saturday, August 14th. We will be renting a 2nd Port a Pottie for the event. For the Food booth, Bill Ritchie, his wife and Joe have voleentered. They will be serving up hot dogs and burgers, chips, soda and Ice cream. Rich Pandey will bring the ice cream. Joe will pick up the meat on the way to the field on Sunday. Jeff Perkins will pick up the buns, Bob Brassell will pick up the chips at Marc's, and Nick Cole might bring the soda. We have enough grills for the day.
