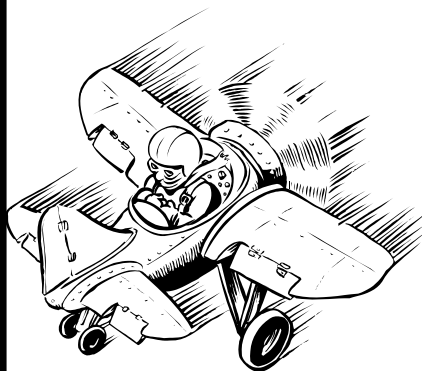

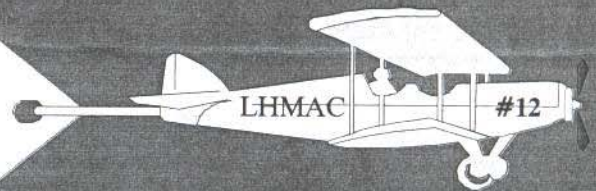
John Shuddic won the raffle, he chose an ARF kit.
