Meeting information:

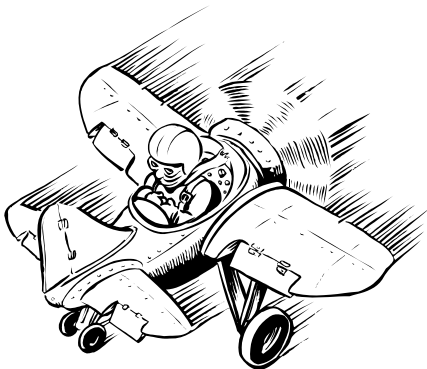
