## Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order by President John Fischer 1:36 P.M.

Intro of new member Wayne Forke.

Minutes of May meeting read by president. Brian Buganski moved acceptance, Wayne Forke seconded.

Financial statement read by Treasurer Tony Oravec. Report accepted.

Porta Potti is in place.

Raffle kits should be in at Daniel's and should soon be picked up.

Field Maintenance committee: Field is being mowed by volunteers, some question whether Cherie has been doing it. Cherie will be contacted.

No other committee reports.

Thanks given to people who showed up on a cold wet Sunday to work on the cleanup.

Barricades: Components are in and cut, only need assembly and installation.

Some stone will be put in where required, probably by Gregory Trucking. \$300.00 was previously approved for this.

New Business. President has had a discussion with Cherie concerning problem with people driving too fast and raising dust clouds from the road. General agreement is that if you see dust behind your vehicle, you are going too fast. Slow down. Speed on the road, from the entrance off Murray Ridge up to the parking area should be no more than 5 to 10 mph. Cherie may try to get license plate numbers. Proposal to set up a three-strike rule on this was proposed and did not meet with any objections. Basic idea, a person's first reported offense will result in a warning, second a term of suspended flying privileges, and third will be dismissal from club. Final format will be discussed at a later date and be brought up at a future meeting. Basic idea is that we don't want to make Cherie have second thoughts about the desirability of having us on her land. Flying fields are getting harder to come by.

Gate. Cherie would like to have the gate closed and locked at night if possible. If the last person leaving at night is certain Cherie is home, please close and lock the gate. The combination is on the back of the membership card.

Cherie also expressed concern about the size of the crowd at last year's Model Mania. She would like to see some kind of control of parking, especially around the horses and the corral.

Please stay away from, and keep other people away from the horses and corral. One of the horses is very calm, but the other could become spooked.

Remember the No Fly Before times. No flying before 8:30 A.M. on weekdays and 10:30 on weekends. If you get to the field before these times and see someone flying, please politely inform the person of these times as a means of retaining the field. People have been flying there before 7:30 A.M.

Since the scheduled July 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting is on a holiday weekend, the membership agreed to change the meeting date to July 10, same time as usual.

There was a question as to whether or not there would be a field available for the proposed Westlake Military Fly-In on Aug 7. A proposal was made to offer the use of our field if acceptable to the membership.

Pond. Nobody has permission to use the pond for any reason except members of Cherie's family. If you see somebody there fishing, it might be good to POLITELY ask, and POITELY inform him or her that the owner doesn't want anybody using the pond. Don't get into an argument or a fight, though.
